



### Sample High School Progression

Grade Level	Typical Courses that Students May Take
9 <sup>th</sup>	Algebra 1 English 1 Science #1 (Usually Physical or Environmental Science) HOPE (Graduation requirement) 2 Electives
10 <sup>th</sup>	Geometry English 2 Science #2 (Biology, which is a graduation requirement) World History 2 Electives
11 <sup>th</sup>	Algebra 2 English 3 Science #3 (Usually Earth Space Science, Chemistry, or Physics) US History 2 Electives
12 <sup>th</sup>	Math #4 English 4 Econ Gov 3 Electives

**Foreign Language:** There is no graduation requirement for foreign language, however students who wish to pursue a path to college should take 2 consecutive years of a foreign language, as that is necessary to be considered for a Bright Futures Scholarship (Example: Spanish 1 and Spanish 2)

**Performing/Fine Arts:** Students also need to take one (1) credit of a Performing/Fine/Practical Art as part of graduation requirements. Examples include: Digital Info Tech, Applied Engineering, Theater, any art or music class, etc.

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
